My name is Monte Chamberlin, Founder of Cost Stewardship and lay Finance leader at the Promise United Methodist Church in Fishers, IN. Please read the following ... it is well worth your time 😊

The filing process can be difficult, paper work is extensive, tax rules change, mistakes can "eliminate" refunds, the Department of Revenue environment can be challenging, etc. For these and many other reasons, exemption filings often should be done by those familiar and comfortable with the process.

Cost Stewardship provides tax exemption services for our churches. We relay exemption certificates to your utilities companies to stop taxation. We file for and attain the maximum refunds possible for our churches. We work for refund sharing %'s ... you keep 100% of future savings.

To get started, we examine your bills and provide a refund estimate, a sharing % proposal and annual savings estimate. While we hope you use our service, the proposal and estimate is free and non-binding. Your church paying less tax and having more funds available for ministries is THE GOAL. We hope to be your partner as this program is what has been able to fund our overall ministry.

Last, we can also check both your utility and phone bills for lower available tariff rates. Electric rates can be incorrectly applied and opportunities to improve phone and natural gas rates do exist.
